How to Donate Seeds

- 1. Please save your seeds from healthy plants, this encourages disease resistance.
- 2. Try to save seeds from several plants so the seed has some genetic diversity in it, for self-pollinating plants less plants are necessary, for cross pollinating you want to save from a larger population of plants.
- 3. For a cross pollinating plant make sure to keep it isolated so it stays "true to type." Check with a seed saving chart or book to learn isolating distances.
- 4. Bring your cleaned, dried seeds into the library in an envelope and fill out our seed donation form to provide us with relevant information.
- 5. Thank you for donating seeds to the library!
